2017 Grocery Getter 35 Rules

The rules and/or regulations set forth herein are designed to provide for the orderly conduct of racing events and to establish minimum acceptable requirements for such events. These rules shall govern the condition of all events, and by participating in these events, all participants are deemed to have complied with these rules. **NO EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF SAFETY SHALL RESULT FROM PUBLICATIONS OF OR COMPLIANCE WITH THESE RULES AND/OR REGULATIONS.** They are intended as a guide for the conduct of the sport and are in no way a guarantee against injury or death to a participant, spectator or official.

The race director shall be empowered to permit reasonable and appropriate deviation from any of the specifications herein or impose any further restrictions that in his opinion do not alter the minimum acceptable requirements. **NO EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF SAFETY SHALL RESULT FROM SUCH ALTERATION OF SPECIFICATIONS.** Any interpretation or deviation of these rules is left to the discretion of the officials. Their decision is final.

No radios, **EXCEPT MANDATORY RACECEIVERS**, allowed in car, or with any pit member or anyone connected with the racecar.

1. **SAFETY EQUIPMENT**

An operational 2-1/2 pound minimum fire extinguisher in each race car and tow vehicles is highly recommended. Extinguisher must be mounted in a quick release bracket. **DUCT TAPE AND ZIP TIES ARE NOT AN ACCEPTABLE MOUNTING DEVICES.**

Rules apply at all times car is on the track. Snell-rated SA2005 or SA2010, SA2015 helmet required. Roll bar padding is highly recommended in driver compartment. SFI – approved full fire suit required for driver and any passengers. Fire retardant gloves also required. Fire retardant shoes are highly recommended. Competitors under the age of 18 are highly recommended to use an SFI 38.1 head and neck restraint system due to the young body and developing bones. Recommended: Fire retardant head sock and underwear, collapsible steering shaft. Driver-side window net required, minimum 16 inch by 20 inch ribbon or mesh style, and must be mounted to roll cage so latch is at top front of window. If there is a passenger in the vehicle it is also mandatory to have a window net on the passenger side. Minimum three inch (two inch with head restraint system) wide SFI-approved five point safety belt assembly required, must be mounted securely to main roll cage. Recommended: Safety belts no more than two years old. Any safety equipment physically or visibly wore or damaged must be replaced, regardless of age. All safety equipment must not be altered and must follow manufacturers use, specifications and requirements for installation.

4 post roll cage required to protect driver and any passengers. Everyone in the vehicle must be in a properly mounted racing seat equipped with a five point harness. Everyone in the vehicle must be in full racing gear. This includes; full fire suit, neck brace, gloves and helmet.

All glass and flammable materials must be removed. Windshield is optional. If you remove the windshield, you must install a minimum of 3 vertical bars in front of the driver and passenger if a passenger is present.

This is a van class. No AWD. No crossovers. Fwd only. No VVT motors.

Raceceivers and transponders are mandatory. If you do not have them we do have them available to rent at the barn.
